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LOCATION

The site is located within the rural Herefordshire village of Gorsley to the south of the B4221. The nearby town of Newent is situated approximately 3.5 miles to the east. J3 of the M50 Motorway is situated 0.6 miles west of the site, providing connections to Bristol and Birmingham via the M5 motorway. Gloucester lies 14 miles to the south east and Hereford 16 miles to the north west, both of which have mainline rail stations providing connections to London.

DESCRIPTION

The site comprises a parcel of agricultural land benefiting from vehicle access off the B4221 as well as pedestrian access off Lovers Walk. A new vehicular access is proposed centrally within the site, off the B4221. The land is delineated by shrubs and mature trees with a gentle slope from west to east. Residential development is located to the west including two bungalows (Mayfield & Ferndale) which abut the south western boundary. To the south lies Linton hall, a late 1800s Victorian dwelling and grounds.

Gorsley offers a number of facilities including a primary school, church, local pub and village hall. The nearby town of Newent offers additional services to include schools, shops, supermarkets, post office and a leisure centre.

A public footpath crosses the site adjacent to the southern boundary. Overhead power lines traverse the site from the south to the north.

PLANNING

The site benefits from outline planning permission for 9 units with all matters reserved except access and layout, granted at appeal on 15 August 2019 (appeal Ref: APP/W1850/W/19/3221618), with the terms of the application (Ref: P181908/F).

The local planning authority is Herefordshire Council; www.herefordshire.gov.uk

PROPOSED SCHEME

The proposed scheme will offer 9 large detached dwellings, together with landscaped areas and an attenuation pond to the east.

SERVICES / ABNORMALS

We understand mains water, electricity and BT are available from the B4221 to the north of the site. Purchasers should satisfy themselves as to services, we have not carried out any tests in this regard.

There is a foul sewer approximately 100m to the west of the site boundary at the closest point. It is proposed that foul drainage is directed to the east of the site via sewers, then pumped across the site, adjacent and parallel to the B4221 before connecting into the local sewer. An attenuation basin, soakaways and infiltration trenches will alleviate surface water, subject to detailed design and regulatory approval.

VIEWING & FURTHER INFORMATION

The site can be viewed via a gate to the north eastern corner of the site, off the B4221. Parties who wish to view the site must do so by prior appointment with Bruton Knowles.

A 'Data Room' has been prepared that provides detailed information on planning, method of sale, topographical survey, ecology, drainage, drawings and other reports.

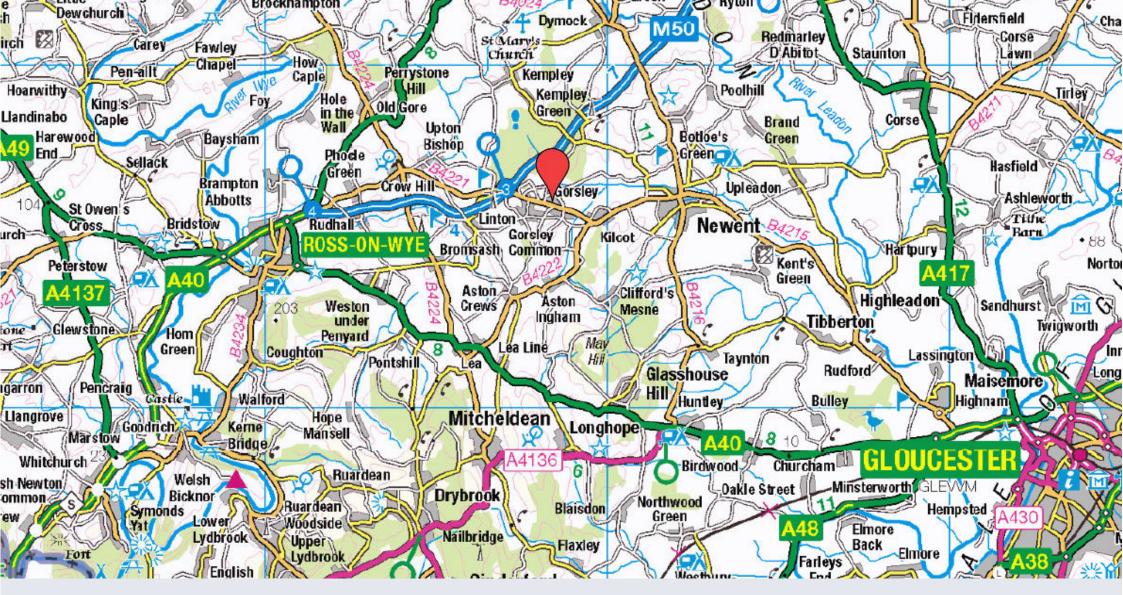
