LOCATION

The property is located to the north-eastern edge of Hereford, along Venns Lane. The location is predominantly residential in nature with several historic properties nearby, as well as more modern estate housing. The subject site is irregularly shaped and gently slopes from northeast to southwest. The site is bound by Venns Lane to the northeast, to the east is Newstead Nursing Home, to the southwest the back gardens of residential dwellings off Admirals Close.

DESCRIPTION

The site is accessed via the main road and within the title ownership is a privately owned estate road which serves both the car park to the rear of the church and also 1 to 9 St Barnabas Close, together with the former vicarage. Boundaries are marked with Stone walling, fencing and mature trees some of which we understand are subject to Tree Preservation Orders (TPO's). To the rear of the building is a tarmac parking area with circa 15 parking spaces together with further circulation space. The site area extends to approximately 0.87 acres to include the shared roadways. On a net basis (excluding the access road) the site extends to approximately 0.7 acres.

The existing building comprises a place of religious worship. The structure is unusual in its design, dating from the 1980's and is constructed over split levels, running down the slope of the site. The building is constructed with brown brick under a multi-pitched slate (or reconstituted slate) roof with bell tower. The front hall is accessed from the front of the site via a walkway and there is a further stepped access to the rear of the building. This leads into a large hall with vaulted ceiling. The building is subdivided with worship hall, kitchen area, storage cupboards, meeting room and further ancillary accommodation.

Accessed separately from a side doorway is a first-floor flat which benefits from an entrance hall, bathroom with bath and w/c, living room and a kitchen off this area. The flat benefits from a single double bedroom.

PLANNING

The Local Planning Authority is Herefordshire Council. The existing planning use is believed to be D1 – Non-Residential Institutions. We assume that the residential apartment will benefit from established open market C3 residential use.

In terms of planning context, we note that the site falls outside of the Aylestone Hill Conservation area, although two Listed heritage assets are located in close proximity to the site (Cox Cottage opposite and Abbey Grange to the north). The property is located within the settlement boundary and is not Listed.

Two feasibility layouts have been commissioned by the vendors illustrating possible residential development schemes on site with demolition of the church premises. Any change of use of the existing structure will require planning permission.

SERVICES

We understand that the property currently benefits from all mains services to include, water, foul drainage, gas and electricity. We are advised that the foul drainage is subject to an attenuation tank and pumped system. We note that the property benefits from both a commercial gas boiler and domestic gas boiler. No tests have been carried out in this regard.

GUIDE PRICE

Guide Price - £700,000. 'Expressions of Interest' are invited.

EPC

We believe that the building is exempt from the requirement for an EPC as is currently a place of worship.

LEGAL INFORMATION

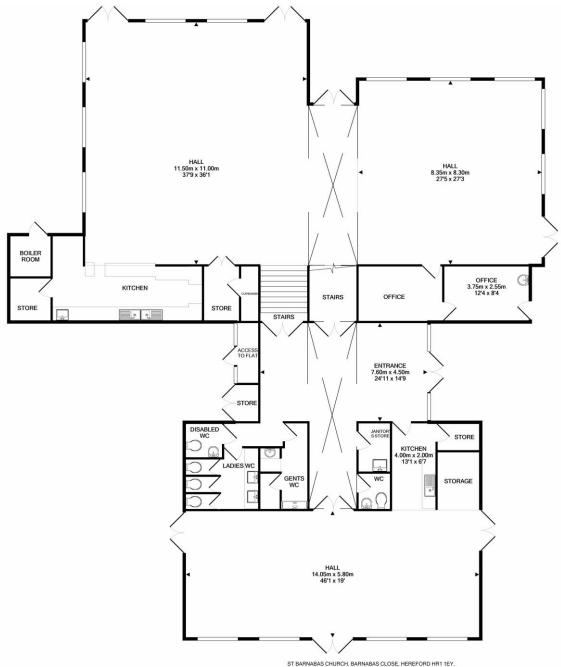

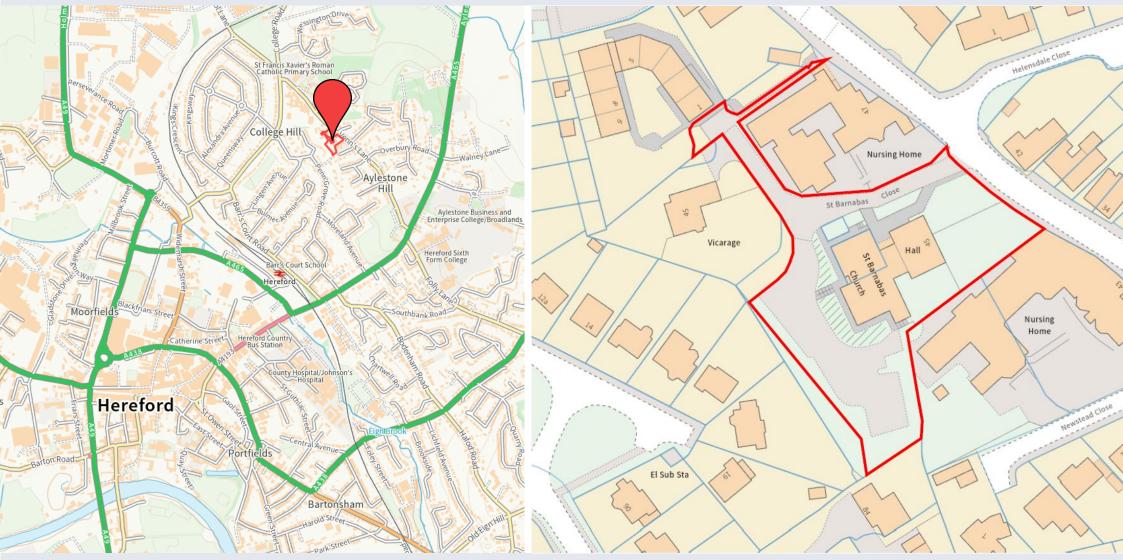
